Introducing teachers and students to new technology and cutting-edge curriculum helps prepare them to meet the challenges of an ever-changing global economy.

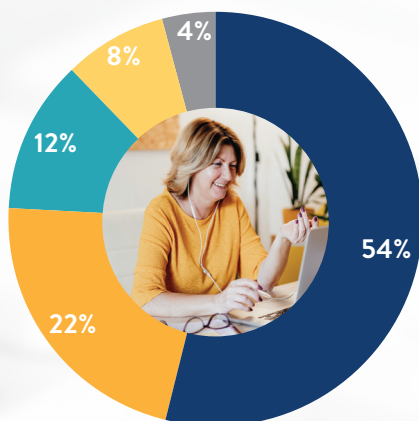


EMPOWER

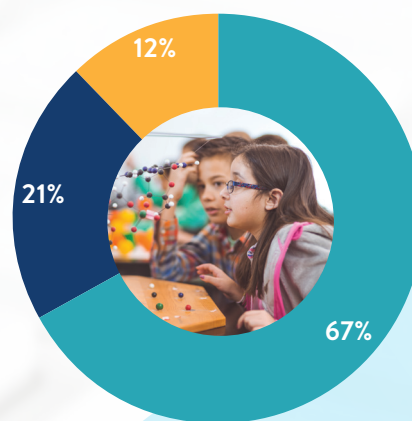

OUR TIME TO SHINE

This year the Krause Center for Innovation celebrated 20 years of delivering highly impactful professional development programs for educators, and achieved many successes during this unprecedented and challenging time. The pandemic caught us by surprise and we all abruptly began working from home. A special challenge for us was to quickly move all our in-person programs to a virtual format while maintaining their special collaborative nature that is so highly valued.

In spite of the pandemic we were able to complete our regularly scheduled summer programs — though in a remote learning format — thanks in large part to financial support from you. Educators in the role of participants learned first-hand what makes a great digital experience as well as how to master tools and techniques for use in their own classrooms, all while engaging the pedagogical concepts found at the core of our work at the KCI.

We started our new fiscal year with a tremendous opportunity to use our own experiences to deliver programs on how to effectively teach via distance learning. Over 1,000 teachers in the Eastside Alliance Schools of San Jose mastered these new techniques. Truly exciting was KCI being awarded state approval to offer a new certificate in Online and Blended Learning so that hundreds more teachers can begin mastering the techniques taught by KCI's expert educators. We will launch this program in October 2020.

In reflection, we began our work 20 years ago basically teaching educators how to use a desktop computer in the classroom. Now the staff talks about introducing artificial intelligence concepts, the challenges of cloud-based computing, and how the advent of additive manufacturing via 3D printers will change our work force. What a long way we have come! Without you, our donors, all of this would not have been possible. However, given continuing changes in technology, our work to enhance professional learning for educators is never-ending. I am incredibly grateful for your partnership and generous support throughout this journey.

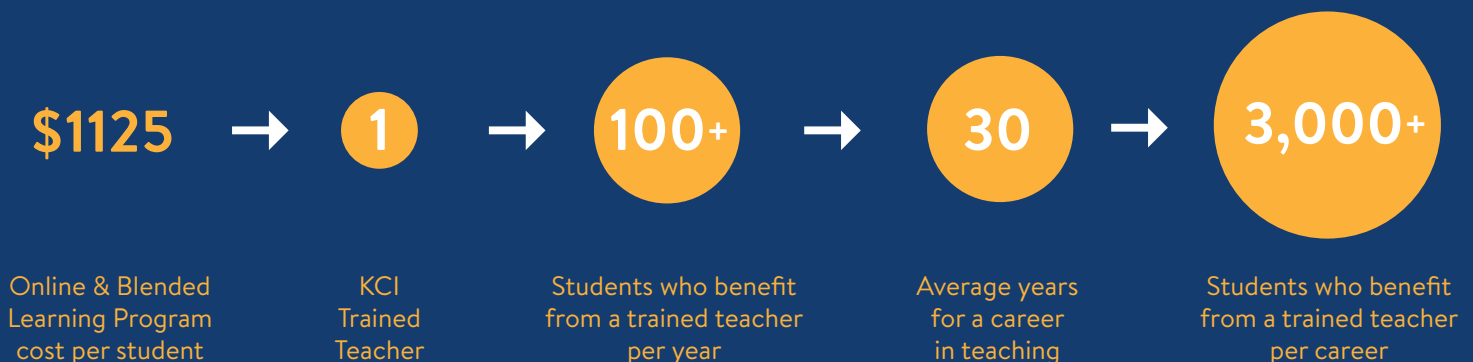
